Douglas Drive has been serving the community since 1973 and over those 51 years, many changes have happened.

We are pleased to share with you some exciting changes coming in September 2024, two brand new groups!

A **New Stroke Support Hub** is to be launched on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2024**. The aim of this group is to offer a safe informal space whereby those living with the effects of Stroke can meet and socialise on a weekly basis.

The group is to run café style with spaces to play games, do an activity or just chill and chat to friends. There will be access to a laptop, stroke information, advice, help, and support

At present we provide 2 Day Care groups for Senior Citizens, including those living with Dementia. However, due to popular demand, we will be adding a **New Day Care Group starting on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2024** and will be run very much in line with our current Monday and Wednesday Groups.

We have opened the lists for both of these new groups so if you, or anyone you know are interested in attending or would just like to know a bit more about Douglas Drive. please do give us a call for an informal chat.

We may be changing our plan but our goal remains the same, to enrich the social lives of Senior Citizens and help to prevent isolation by meeting people in similar situations.

They will be raising money for 2 charities, Douglas Drive and Macmillan Cancer Support.

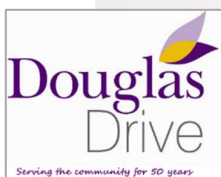
If you're looking for something to do, pop along and say Hello. Sounds like it's going to be a great day and we will be there with our family games stall!
